**RCIA CORNER FOR FEBRUARY 21, 2010**

On Saturday at the Rite of Election by Bishop Emeritus Walter Sullivan, and based on the testimony by their Sponsors and the Prince of Peace community, our adult and children RCIA catechumens re-affirmed their intentions and advanced closer to the sacraments of initiation—Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist. The Church has thus made an “election” to admit those who have shown a disposition that makes them fit to take part in our sacramental life. This serious step has required them to undergo a conversion in both mind and action and to begin a life-long journey to develop themselves in the faith. Their continuing discernment is prompted by the Holy Spirit and has been consistently encouraged by your prayers.
