## Maison Fortuné Orphanage Update

On behalf of the children at Maison Fortune Orphanage and Jean-Louis, a big thank you to all those who contributed items to the container we recently sent to Haiti. The container was packed the second week in June and should take 4 to 6 weeks for the goods to arrive at the orphanage. The container had new sneakers, boys and girls clothing, some adult clothing, medical supplies, personal hygiene items, a copier, sheets, notebooks and other school supplies along with miscellaneous other items. The Prince of Peace parishioners were terrific in their support of this effort. And a big thank you to the office staff for their help in collecting and storing the goods. In addition, 50 bicycles were purchased for use by the older children to ride to and from high school each day. Before the bikes, the children were walking over 2 miles each way, every weekday in all kinds of weather. Sometimes we receive questions and the one most often asked is, "How can I help?" We usually respond in either or both of these two ways: 1) Spread the word about the good work being done by Jean-Louis and so many others to help the children of Maison Fortune. 2) Become a sponsor. We now have almost 230 children at the orphanage (up from 150 before the earthquake) and sponsorship provides a way to help us budget based upon a steady flow of donations.
